One constant in life is change. Prison ministry is challenging. We minister to people that are easily forgotten. We are called by Jesus to minister in institutions whose primary concern is security. We are not in control. We must follow the rules and limitations of the institutions or we lose the ability to minister.

But as challenging as prison ministry can be, the pandemic has made it more challenging. We continue working persistently, patiently, and prayerfully to get back into institutions where we once had a regular presence. We celebrate each time we hear about a reopening or a new ministry begun in a new place.

YPM has been creative during days of exile from in-prison ministry, emphasizing forming mentoring relationships and a new ministry that " Meets at the Door" returning citizens, with a ride to home or half-way house, basic needed items, and a first meal and prayer outside prison walls.

There has been a very significant staff change at YPM as well. On March 1, 2023 Carl Geissinger passed the baton of leadership to NW/SW Regional Director Sean Atkinson. Carl has been a YPM volunteer since 1983 and our Executive Director for the last four and one-half years. Carl has led faithfully and skillfully through a most critical time in our history and now returns to service as a Yokefellow volunteer. Sean Atkinson brings a similar heart for the people we serve and a love for Christ who came to serve us.

Change may come, but our vital mission remains the same. YPM's mission is to "help at-risk youth (young people who have had an encounter with the criminal justice system), inmates, and returning citizens yoke themselves to Christ for salvation and changed lives."

Thanks for helping do for others what Christ has done for each of us.

## 2022 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT



**In-Prison Ministry** - One of the huge challenges of this ministry over the past three years has been the Covid shutout of volunteers from many prisons. Through the 2022 year, doors have been gradually opening to volunteers. As 2022 ended, we were back into 22 of the 44 prisons in which we were ministering prior to the pandemic. We are thankful to be back into 22, but we will give our best effort to getting back into all those prisons and into new prisons where we were not ministering prior to Covid. As a matter of fact, we have begun a new ministry at the Schuylkill County Prison and are in the process of beginning ministries at Butler and Adams County Prisons. These are prisons where we were not serving prior to Covid.

**MENTORING** - For many years some YPM volunteers have been involved in one-on-one mentoring relationships with inmates and returning citizens without an intentional ministry structure. The Covid shutout has prompted us to put more intentional focus on mentoring. Through the past year we have made significant progress in the development of mentoring relationships in YPM. We have around 12 active mentoring relationships and with our new mentor training and mentoring structure, we expect that to grow exponentially. Mentoring will focus on ministry to both returning citizens and inmates.

**INMATE BOOK** - We were blessed with the release of the **Get Free and Stay Free** book in July, which told the stories of eleven persons who were ministered to by Yokefellowship volunteers in prison and have built solid lives upon release. The book sold around 900 copies in the last six months of 2022. Around half of them were on Amazon sales and around half were mailed in bulk to prisons which requested a bulk supply for inmates.

**ANNUAL CONFERENCE** - Our annual conference was held on Sept. 23-24, 2022 at the Genetti Hotel in Williamsport. The theme of the conference was Get Free and Stay Free. Most of the presenters were persons whose stories were in the book. Videos of our 2022 conference and our 2021 conference are available on YouTube. **YPM FUTURE** - We are excited about the new and ongoing developments of this ministry, but the heart of this ministry is the weekly small groups that are happening in 22 prisons around the state. Faithful volunteers are giving of their time and gas money to help yoke inmates to Christ for salvation and changed lives. Hundreds of inmates are touched, ministered to and discipled by these volunteers. Lives are changed in big and small ways as inmates and returning citizens are growing in a life shaping relationship with Jesus.

YPM's mission is to "help at-risk youth, inmates, and returning citizens yoke themselves to Christ for salvation and changed lives." YPM is a 501c3 umbrella organization with local Area Council (AC) affiliates. A governing board of directors, elected by representatives from areas served, provides direction and oversight to the growing ministry. In 2022 there were 15 Area Councils serving throughout PA. Each AC has its own governing body; recruits, trains, and assigns volunteers; has its own treasury and budget; and is asked to contribute 25% of its net income to the parent overarching ministry. Through these ACs, hundreds of volunteers are entering nearly half of the county, state, and federal adult correctional institutions in PA.


**YPM** grew out of a fellowship movement started in 1955 by Dr. Elton Trueblood (1900-1994), a renowned author, speaker, and theologian. Trueblood believed being a Christian was synonymous to being yoked with Christ (MATTHEW 11:28-30) and that we need to heed the call of PHILIPPIANS 4:3 to help others, "Yes, I ask you loyal yokefellow....". Regarding incarceration, Trueblood stated, "Separation from the world for a while is justified if new life emerges."

"Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me for I am gentle and humble in heart and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

**YPM** focuses on **small group discussions** for spiritual and personal growth through learning and practicing Bible-based disciplines. The result is the changed lives of those we serve as well as our own. The following selected attributes of discipleship are highly valued and taught as "marks" of a Yokefellow:

- Commitment Hearing Christ's call "Come to me" a Yokefellow knows his answer gives a center of stability in life as he or she also joins Christ in lifting the burdens of others.
- Discipline A Yokefellow voluntarily accepts:
- Discipline of Prayer pray daily.
- Discipline of Scripture read reverently and thoughtfully a portion of Scripture daily, following a definite plan.
- The Discipline of Worship to share, at least weekly, in the public worship of God.
- Discipline of Money give a definite portion of my income to the promotion of Christ's cause and as an act of worship.
- **Discipline of Time -** use my time as a sacred gift, not to be wasted, striving to make my daily work, whatever it may be, a Christian vocation.
- Discipline of Service daily lift some human burden.
- Discipline of Study develop mental powers by careful reading and study.
- Witness A Yokefellow is one who knows that faith in Christ is not a private affair; to be kept it must be shared.
- Ministry A Yokefellow is one who participates in the universal ministry. The New Testament is clear; all are called and all are recruits in Christ's cause (Ephesians 4:1).
- Fellowship It is impossible to be a Christian in isolation. A Yokefellow finds or produces a redemptive Christian fellowship.



## We In Yokefellowship Prison Ministry Believe:

- God There is one eternal, almighty, and perfect God in essence, revealed in three persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. We are faithful to the biblical revelation that in one sense God is one and in a different sense He is three. Deut 6:4, Matt 3:16-17, Matt 28:19
- **Jesus Christ** Jesus Christ is true God and true Man, born of a virgin, died for our sins, rose from the dead, and will return in glory and power. *Matt* 1:20, *Matt* 16:27, *Rom* 1:3-4
- The Holy Spirit When a person becomes born again, by believing and receiving Jesus Christ, God resides in that person through the Holy Spirit. All the divine attributes ascribed to the Father and the Son are equally ascribed to the Holy Spirit. Gen 1:26, Acts 2:28, 1 Cor 3:16
- **The Word** The Bible is the inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God given through the Holy Spirit for the purpose of teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness. 2 *Tim 3:16-17*, *Heb 4:12-13*, 2 *Pet 1:20-21*

As Yokefellows, we are called to provide a ministry of reconciliation to those who are or were incarcerated, always showing love and respect to all persons. Matt 5:16, 2 Cor 5:20, Eph 6:17-20
- The Body of Christ All believers are members of the body of Christ. With Christ as the "head," every member is called to have a personal relationship with Him, to be His disciple, to love one another, and to use our gifts for the body. *John 12:26, 1 Cor 12:27, Col* 1:18
- The New Covenant Those who yoke themselves to Christ are no longer part of the Old Covenant. Though the OT law is good in that it showed us our need for Christ and how to please God, Christians live by and are under a new covenant of grace alone. Having been released from the law, we are to live by grace and our lives are to continually reflect the glory of God. Gal 3:13-14, Gal 3:19, 1 Tim 1:8
- The Reward For taking the message of God's transforming love and forgiveness to captives and sharing the grace that has been given to us, great will be our reward in heaven.
